CVPO Future

- Current CVPO officers are not available to serve next year
- We provide meetings about once per month and plan brainstorming more participation
- We use the teacher grants and fund them. Our non-profit status means that we don't pay extra fees when using our donations to fund school programs

Fundraising efforts and recruiting for officers and volunteer

- Signs will be created and displayed to increase donations.
- Teacher grants were placed on hold this year
- One notable issue with enrolling volunteer help is that background checks turn around may be too long, discouraging parents from participating

Principal McKee:

- We are looking for volunteers for the Japan exchange program
- We're also looking for volunteers for the end of year library wrap up,
- Clubs tend to go to the student council for money, making this a good opportunity for a partnership with CVPO. This would make it easier to centralize fundraising efforts for the school. Since the Core Council meets on Tuesday at lunch, a CVPO representative will meet with the ASB group to explore a partnership.
- For those that may want to give donations, CVPO can offer a tax break as incentive

Next steps:

- Meet with Ms. Stone so we can see what our possibilities are for a partnership with the Core Council. Find out if the kids know what needs funding next Fall.
- Reach out to staff to find out what general needs are for next Fall (maybe fundraise for this Spring/Summer). Hit the ground running by September.
- We will need to find officers and hold board elections so that CVPO can continue. For this end, Tze will send out the bylaws so there is communication
- Have Mr. McKee ask the school staff what their needs are for next Fall. Preferably set up a google form ourselves.
- Potentially communicate with the middle schools so that we can increase involvement (Lina Digregorio)
