Introduction

- Tze-Yiu Yong opened the meeting by welcoming attendees and providing a brief introduction to the Crescent Valley Parent Organization (CVPO). The CVPO aims to:
 - Encourage parent interest in Crescent Valley High School (CVHS).
 - Promote parent-school relations through volunteer engagement and support activities.
 - Support school activities involving students, parents, and faculty, including a teacher grant program

Principal's Update

- Aaron McKee addressed rumors about potential school closures, clarifying that no decisions have been made. A committee will convene in August to discuss the district's future, including potential school closures and boundary shifts.
- Student Transfers: Aaron provided data on student transfers, noting 24 students transferring into CVHS and 15 transferring to Corvallis High School (CHS). He explained various reasons for transfers, including sibling attendance and district employee preferences.

School Board Perspective

 Bernard P Wang emphasized that no decisions regarding school closures have been made and encouraged parents to stay connected and participate in budget committee meetings.

O&A Session

- AP Spanish and AP Physics: Aaron discussed the challenges of offering single sections of AP classes and the benefits of sharing resources with CHS. He also addressed concerns about the prerequisites for AP Physics.
- **German Language Program:** Aaron confirmed that German 2 will be offered next year, but German 1 and higher levels will not be available due to the retirement of the German teacher.
- **Busing Issues:** Aaron acknowledged the ongoing issues with busing, primarily due to a shortage of drivers, and mentioned efforts to address the problem by adjusting start and end times.
- Robotics Program: Aaron shared plans to integrate the robotics program into the Career and Technical Education (CTE) program, highlighting the benefits of CTE funding and support.

Closing Remarks

• Community Engagement: Aaron encouraged parents to get involved in promoting CVHS and supporting the school's initiatives. He mentioned the

importance of the sister school relationship with Nichidai in Japan and the need for host families for visiting students.
